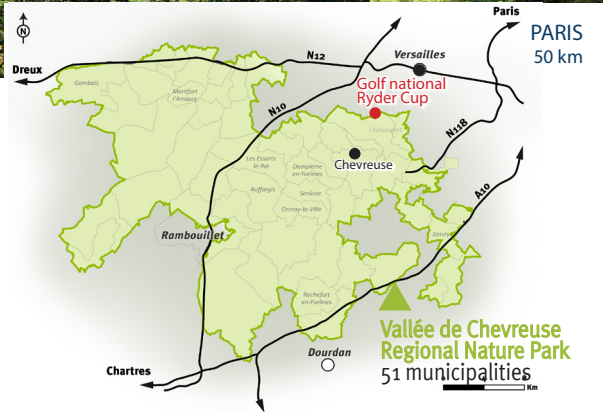

The Regional Nature Park ensures natural and cultural heritage is protected and managed.
